

The National Reserve of Hunting and Wildlife of Caroux-Espinouse



Located in the heart of the Massif du Caroux-Espinouse, the Reserve rises to over 1100m above sea level. It has a great diversity of landscapes due to its rugged topography and its climate on the boundary of Oceanic and Mediterranean influences. The Reserve hosts an important and remarkable biodiversity that led locals to implement strict safeguards to preserve the landmarks.

The Reserve had a goal: the successful introduction of 19 Corsican Mouflon (endangered in its native habitat), conducting studies and repopulation of new territories. This introduction was a success and now the Corsican Mouflon has colonized more than 20,000 ha in the Massif du Caroux-Espinouse. Now, this is the largest Corsican Mouflon population in France and the most renowned in hunting and in the science field.

So if you want to enjoy beautiful rocky landscapes, forest and green space, and if you hope to see some of our famous Corsican Mouflon, being watched from the corner of the eye of a Golden Eagle from the top of his perch, come to discover our beautiful Languedoc Mountains!
