

Estagnol: the small pond of discovery



Located only 8Km from Montpellier, in the town of Villeneuve-Lès-Maguelone (Hérault, Languedoc-Roussillon), the Reserve of Estagnol enjoys a Mediterranean climate, favorable for the different species that live there or are passing through (as migratory birds).

On its 78 hectares, the freshwater pond shelters many natural habitats, hosting an exceptional wildlife and flora. Scientific research conducted on the site led to beautiful discoveries and knowledge of local and national biodiversity.

The partnerships forged with local actors (biodiversity experts, public institutions, hunters, universities, schools, etc.) contribute to improving scientific knowledge, share expertise and create truly interdisciplinary exchanges, which are the wealth of the Reserve of Estagnol!
