Guidelines for poster presentations

- DO NOT FORGET: After your abstract as been accepted, you must register for the meeting and pay your fees
- Poster orientation: only portrait
- Poster size: A0 (84 x 120 cm) or slightly smaller, in portrait layout
- Be aware that your poster should be understandable without oral explanation (without too much text, be concise) and should be readable from 2 meters away. So, use readable fonts such as Times New Roman or Arial at a minimum size of 20pt. Do not use complex backgrounds that distract from the main message. Do not report too much data. Please, focus on the take-home message
- Poster display: Posters should be fixed to boards using Velcro tape (provided at the reception desk). You are responsible for the setup and take-down of your poster before and after your poster session.
- Be at your poster during the poster session to discuss your work with scientists visiting your poster
- Provide an envelope with A4 copies of your poster, and your card, that scientists can take home if interested.
- Provide another envelope where scientists can leave their cards for further contact.
